Objective:

Students will demonstrate an understanding of form through movement. (ABBA)

Materials:

Recording of "Call Me Maybe" by Carly Rae Jepsen

## Procedure:

- 1. Show the class I have two different signs
- 2. Have them watch me for the first ABBA group using the two signs to dictate the form
- 3. Divide into group of five and ask each group to come up with two different movements
- 4. Watch me again and join me as soon as possible
- 5. Have class complete task on own
- 6. Ask questions!

## **Questions:**

What changed throughout the song? Why did my movements change? Did the words affect my motions? When were the words the same? When were they different?

## **Evaluation:**

Can students recognize when a segment of music repeats itself later in music?

## Extension:

Learn the terminology of form. Use a different song. Learn about form with a 'C' in it. Have students write a chorus to a song and two verses, and then have students put them in the proper order for a standard ABA form progression.
